We listen to the concerns of the community and our priorities are set by local people who sit on a neighbourhood panel. You said the following priorities were important to you:

- Residential Burglary
- Motor Vehicle Crime
- Domestic Violence / Hate Crime

We did

We have done the following to tackle these priorities:

Priority 1: Residential Burglary

Burglary is still a borough priority on Fulham town ward there was **4** Residential burglaries from the period of **01/11/16 to 05/12/16** Attempted burglaries were **0**

We are encouraging residents to continue to be vigilant - use both Chubb and Yale locks close and lock all windows when going out.... Residents will need to be cautious over the festive season as burglars Will be aware that high value presents may be stored in properties.

Priority 2: Motor Vehicle Crime

There has been no increase in theft from motor vehicles, **12** in total in the Fulham area over the period of **01/11/16 to 05/12/16**

Small valuable items, particularly mobile phones, Sat Nav systems and Laptop Computers are often stolen if left in unattended vehicles. Whenever possible, motorists

are reminded not to leave anything of value on show. We recommend www.immobilise.com to register your electrical goods with their serial numbers. This is a police website that stores all your information and is checked when goods are recovered or when subjects are arrested with items believed to be stolen.

Priority 3: Domestic Violence / Hate Crime

In the period between **01/11/16 to 05/12/16** reported DV crimes was **3** two of which were Common Assault and one being ABH. No Hate crime was reported on the ward.

Fulham Town SNT continue to liaise with residents and local Authorities in order to identify ASB hotspots and make our patrols More focused and effective.
